Anna's Taqueria has an opening date for new Natick restaurant. Here's when it happens

Key Points

- Anna's Taqueria will open on Route 9 in Natick on May 13.
- The new restaurant will occupy a former B.Good restaurant that closed in January.
- The chain started in Brookline in 1995 and now has locations throughout Greater Boston.

The new Anna's Taqueria on Route 9 in Natick has set an opening date.

[Anna's Taqueria](#) will begin serving its burritos, tacos and quesadillas in Natick on Tuesday, May 13, a spokesperson for the restaurant confirmed. The 1265 Worcester St. (Route 9) location will be the 10th for Anna's Taqueria, and joins several that have been converted from the former B.Good.

Plans for the Natick Anna's Taqueria were announced in February, after the closure of B.Good. Both are chains owned by Andover-based [Streetlight Ventures](#), which also has in its portfolio [Burtons](#), [Margaritas Mexican Restaurant](#), [Red Heat American Tavern](#) and [Otto Pizza](#).

Anna's first opened in 1995 in Brookline. According to its website, Anna's was first conceived with the goal of bringing home-style flavors of Mexican street food from [San Francisco's Mission District](#) to Greater Boston. The restaurant serves burritos, tacos, quesadillas and bowls with customizable ingredients.

Anna's Taqueria has four locations in Boston, and one each in Brookline, Cambridge, Newton, Somerville and Woburn.

The restaurant will be open daily from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. and is hiring staff, according to its website.
